Dear Dr. Patel:

At your request, we have reviewed the materials you submitted for the training course, *Bloodborne Pathogens for Body Piercers*, that you propose to conduct for compliance with the Department of Health (DOH) required training for body piercers and salon operators. The purpose of the review was to determine if the materials meet the annual refresher training requirements for operators and piercers as required by Chapter 64E-19, *Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.)*.

Based upon the materials submitted, this refresher course meets the minimum requirements set forth in subsection 64E-19.007(6), *F.A.C.* Documentation of successful completion of this course will reflect compliance with the annual refresher training requirement for operators and piercers of body-piercing establishments.

Pursuant to paragraph 64E-19.007(6)(e), *F.A.C.*, any changes made to a training course that has been reviewed and accepted by the department shall also be submitted to the Bureau of Community Environmental Health for review prior to implementation of the changes.

It is the policy of the Bureau to monitor all courses that have been reviewed and accepted by the Bureau for compliance with the training requirements for body piercers and salon operators set forth in Chapter 64E-19, *F.A.C.* We will contact you in the future to schedule such a monitoring.
