

HIPAA PRIVACY & SECURITY BASIC COURSE



The Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) requires all practitioners to ensure the privacy and security of patient information. The Privacy and Security rules went into effect on April 14, 2003, with stiff penalties for those who fail to comply, or who improperly disclose or misuse protected health information.

The HIPAA Privacy and Security Rules dictate that all who may come into contact with a patient's healthcare information go through a training on HIPAA policy, and that there be documentation to prove that the training has been completed. Biologix's HIPAA training course takes you through several slides which allow you to read about HIPAA, understand current issues in HIPAA compliance, and take mini test/quiz as you move through the program. Upon completion of the course you will receive a Certificate of Completion.

This program explains the HIPAA regulations pertaining to the privacy and security of personal healthcare information. The topics covered in the program include:
