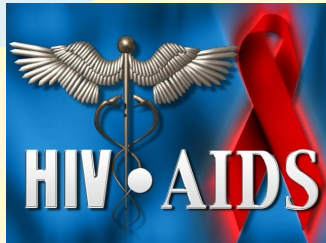


## HIV/AIDS FOR KENTUCKY HEALTH PROFESSIONALS

- Community based organizations (CBOs) and prevention services resources for HIV information and support in Kentucky.
